

# THE LOUISE AND GEORGE LYON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Lyons were lifelong members of the Ocean Park Civic League and dedicated a good portion of their free time to serving the community in which they lived. They were especially committed to supporting the Ocean Park Volunteer Rescue Squad, which was the first, all voluntary, rescue squad established in Virginia Beach and which is still in operation today on Shore Drive.

# **RULES FOR APPLICATION**

## GENERAL

- A. The Scholarship is offered by the Ocean Park Civic League (OPCL). Members of the OPCL shall serve on the scholarship selection committee.
- B. The purpose of the Scholarship Fund is to provide a grant of \$1,000.00 to a qualified student, as determined by the OPCL, for the period of one school year AND up to three subsequent years to the in-state postsecondary institution as long as the student maintains a 2.8 GPA. If the 2.8 GPA is not maintained, the scholarship is no longer in effect.
- C. Applications will be posted at Virginia Beach Schools Scholarship Central and at <u>www.OPCL.org</u>
- D. In determining the annual recipient, primary consideration will be based on need for financial assistance (Family Income < \$180,000), community service, and overall qualifications, with additional consideration being given to residents of Ocean Park, if applicable.
- E. The OPCL reserves the right to discontinue the Scholarship Fund at any time.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Applicants must be senior year students in an accredited high school in Virginia Beach.
- B. Applicants must have been a resident of Virginia Beach, Virginia for at least one year preceding the date of application.
- C. Applicants must attend a college, nursing program, or accredited postsecondary career/vocational school in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- D. Applicants must be a student in good standing and maintain a grade point average of at least 2.8 while receiving the scholarship.
- E. If an applicant must change schools within the Commonwealth of Virginia during the scholarship award period, s/he must notify the OPCL representative no later than the end of the academic year preceding the change. As long as the student remains at an institution in Virginia, eligibility is not affected.

## **APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:**

- A. The Application Information page completed in full.
- B. A short essay on why you believe volunteerism is important, and how you have made a positive contribution in your community through your volunteer efforts.
- C. Three (3) letters of reference:
  - a. One (1) personal reference from an official or teacher at your school
  - b. One (1) from a mentor or leader for whom you are volunteering/working.
  - c. One (1) from persons other than relatives.
- D. Application must be signed by the student <u>and</u> the applicant's parent or guardian.
- E. Official High School Transcript

## RECIPIENT

- A. Recipient will be notified of selection at or before the school's Senior Awards Assembly.
- B. The recipient is required to advise the OPCL scholarship chairperson of the name and the address of the institution to which the funds are to be sent. Specific directions will be provided to the recipient in the award letter.
- C. The recipient is also required to provide a college transcript at the end of each academic year in order to prove eligibility for the next award year.
