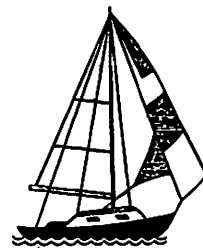

SHORE DRIVE CORRIDOR PLAN WINS APPROVAL!

The first step of a plan to enhance the environs of Shore Drive has been reached by the Shore Drive Advisory Commission. The City of Virginia Beach Planning Commission voted unanimously to send the plan that took eighteen months to create to the City Council for approval in March. The comprehensive plan will ask the City to include approximately 30 million dollars in its budget to fund the first portions of the plan. Although it might be overly optimistic to expect complete funding of the plan, hopefully a large portion of the request will be included in the City capital improvement budget this year. Certainly the Shore Drive corridor is due for some improvements.

It is important that citizens attend the City Council Annual Budget meeting which is open to the public. Here, citizens will have the opportunity to voice their approval of this very important funding incentive for the Shore Drive corridor.

New Shore Drive Community Coalition

On February 3rd, members from approximately fifteen civic associations and

business enterprises along the Shore Drive corridor met to discuss the possibility joining forces to promote an involvement in the OpSail 2000 event in mid-June. Out of necessity for us to meet this challenge and future challenges along the Shore Drive corridor a new organization was created: The Shore Drive Community Coalition (SDCC) came into existence to manage OpSail 2000, a milestone of Chesapeake Bay history. In the future, the SDCC will be a strong advocate for issues concerning the Shore Drive Corridor.



The historic OpSail 2000 event, the assemblage of 30 or more tall ships in Lynnhaven Roads off Cape Henry on June 15, 2000, is a once in a lifetime opportunity for the Shore Drive area to be showcased in the Mid-Atlantic region of the nation and throughout the world.

Approximately 1,500 cadets/sailors from eighteen nations will come ashore at the Virginia Pilots Association facility on Shore Drive

Thursday evening, June 15th. One civic league could not handle the planning of such an event. The combination of volunteers from the civic leagues, condominium associations, and the local merchants association are already hard at work making plans. The City of Virginia Beach has informally committed \$35,000 to facilitate this notable occasion.

On Thursday, February 24th, the SDCC Events Committee will make a formal presentation to the City of Virginia Beach on the SDCC plan to showcase the area's hospitality on June 15th. With the short time remaining until then, a concerted effort must be made to bring the plan

together. Many volunteers have come forward to assist, however, more are needed. Efforts will be addressed to fund-raising and manning a hospitality center for the visiting sailors. The SDCC is confident that the event will be a great success and it will set the stage for what is hoped will be an annual Shore Drive celebration. 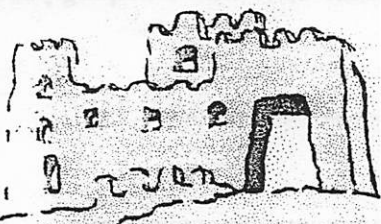

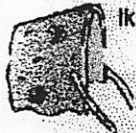
