

Zoning Laws Must Be Heeded, Always

Several recent cases in our community illustrates the necessity for doing your homework prior to embarking on an addition or renovation project on your property. In one case, a resident who built a deck extending into a setback and then appeared before the Board of Zoning Appeals seeking a variance for that deck was denied the variance. Upon an appeal to the Circuit Court, the decision of the Zoning Board was upheld and the resident was ordered to remove the deck within 60 days and a fine was imposed. Therefore, it seems that the prudent thing to do is to first check with the city's zoning division to avoid any costly mistakes, keeping in mind that variances are technically granted only in cases of hardship.
